1. Call to order

Mayor Eric Turpen called the meeting to order at 6:00p.m.

2. Invocation

6. Consider and Approve Minutes from the January 25th Meeting.

7. Consider and Approve Monthly Departmental Reports: Police Dept.; Fire Dept.; EMS; Code Enforcement; Animal Control; Landfill; Water/Wastewater; Streets and Parks; Municipal Court; Monthly Financial Reports; Sales Tax Collection; Property Tax Collection reports; LEDC A and B minutes, if Boards met.

Consider and Approve An Ordinance of the City of Littlefield, Texas, Adopting Amendment No. 2 to the Original Budget of the City of Littlefield, Texas, for the Fiscal Year 2021-2022, Funding Accounts in Budget Due to Unforeseen Situations; Containing Findings; Providing for Severability; and Providing Other Details Relating to the Subject Regarding Recent Purchase of Compactor, Compressor, Park Trail, and Pool Landscaping.

Mayor Eric Turpen made the motion to approve the ordinance. Mayor pro tempore Kenny Rucker made the second motion. The motion passed unanimously.

11. Consider and Approve Additional Costs for annual Seal Coat Due to Higher than Anticipated Engineering Estimates.

Mayor Eric Turpen made the motion to approve Option #1, including E. 14<sup>th</sup> St. from Hall Ave. to Delano Ave., allowing swap out of Reed St. for E. 14<sup>th</sup> St. change and allowing discretion of City Manager to seal coat Reed St., if possible. Council Member Eric Saenz made the second motion. The motion passed unanimously.


12. Adjourn
