11. Consider and Approve Agreement Between City of Littlefield EMS and City of Anton

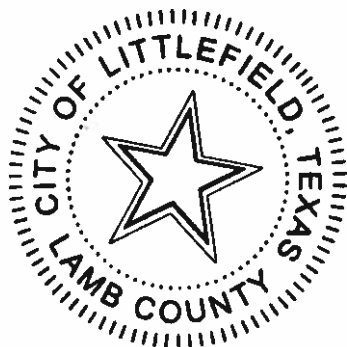
The motion to approve was made by Council Member Ben Warren. The second motion was made by Council Member Buddy Holmes. The motion passed unanimously.
