WHEREAS, the citizens of Littlefield desire to have a clean and healthy community which everyone can be proud to live in; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of Littlefield has determined that elimination of dangerous and dilapidated structures is very important and, when accomplished, should be a source of pride for the citizens of Littlefield; and

WHEREAS, we wish to recognize that many of these 50 structures were demolished by property owners at their own expense; and

WHEREAS, the Blight Elimination project has had full support from the Littlefield Independent School District and Lamb County through joint dedication of seizure money toward demolitions and clean ups; and

WHEREAS, the continued enforcement of our Code of Ordinances shall markedly improve the aesthetic appearance of our community's lands, safety, health and welfare of all our citizens; and

WHEREAS, Texas Community Groups has provided legal services to make sure these actions are done correctly; and
